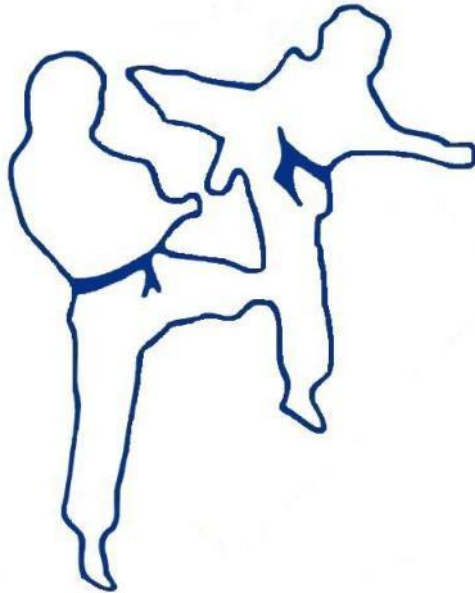

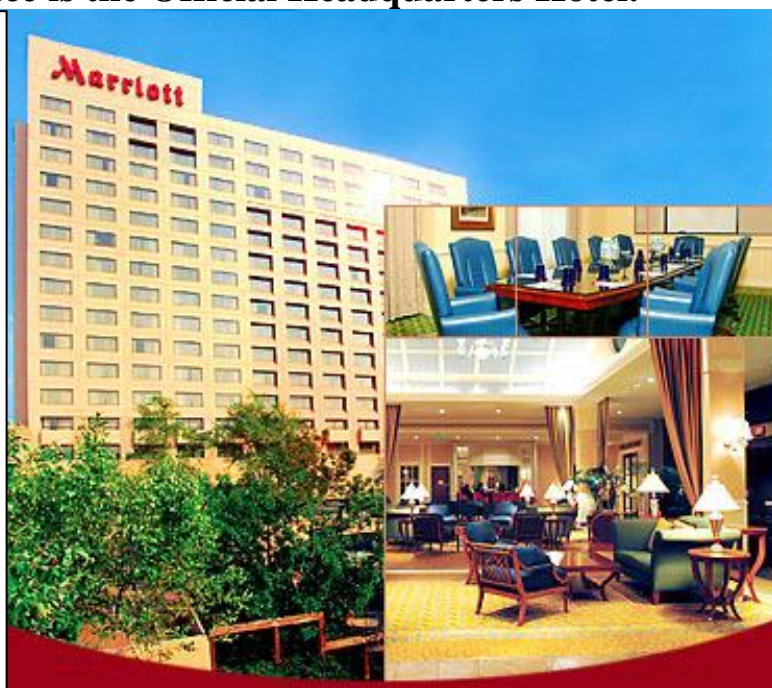

All competitors MUST report to staging in the old gym 15 minutes before the appointed time for their division.

All 14 and Up Black Belts must report to staging at 9:30AM for weigh-ins

RULES: AAU Taekwondo Rules as documented in the 2010 AAU Taekwondo Handbook will be used for governing sparring competition. Rules can be downloaded at www.aautaekwondo.org. This is not an AAU Sanctioned Event.

Forms Competition: Forms competition is not limited to WTF, ITF or TSD systems. All Korean and Japanese style forms will be accepted. No 'extreme martial arts' movements will be allowed

Breaking Competition: Board breaking will also be offered. In the breaking competition there will be a limit of three breaks with **boards only**. Three boards will be supplied for those that sign up for this division of competition. The boards used will be 1 inch pine. Various sizes will be offered depending on the size of the contestant. Only boards supplied at the event may be used. No individual break will be allowed to exceed three boards. Additional boards may be purchased at the event for \$2 each. Board holders will be available at the event

Coaches: All coaches must purchase a Coaches Pass. The coach's application and fee (\$10) must be received by November 17, 2009. Coaches may purchase a Coaches Pass at the event for a fee of \$25.

Uniform and Sparring Gear: Only white uniforms will be allowed. Trim on collar, school name on back of uniform top, and school patches will be allowed. We will be using the same requirements for equipment as is allowed in AAU Competitions. The only exception to equipment is that in Point Style Sparring, sparring gear and head gear can be any color.

All Athletes, Coaches and Officials must check in prior to entering Gym. Please report to staging early. Staging times are listed above. All 14 and up Black Belts will be required to weigh-in in dobok at 9:30am.

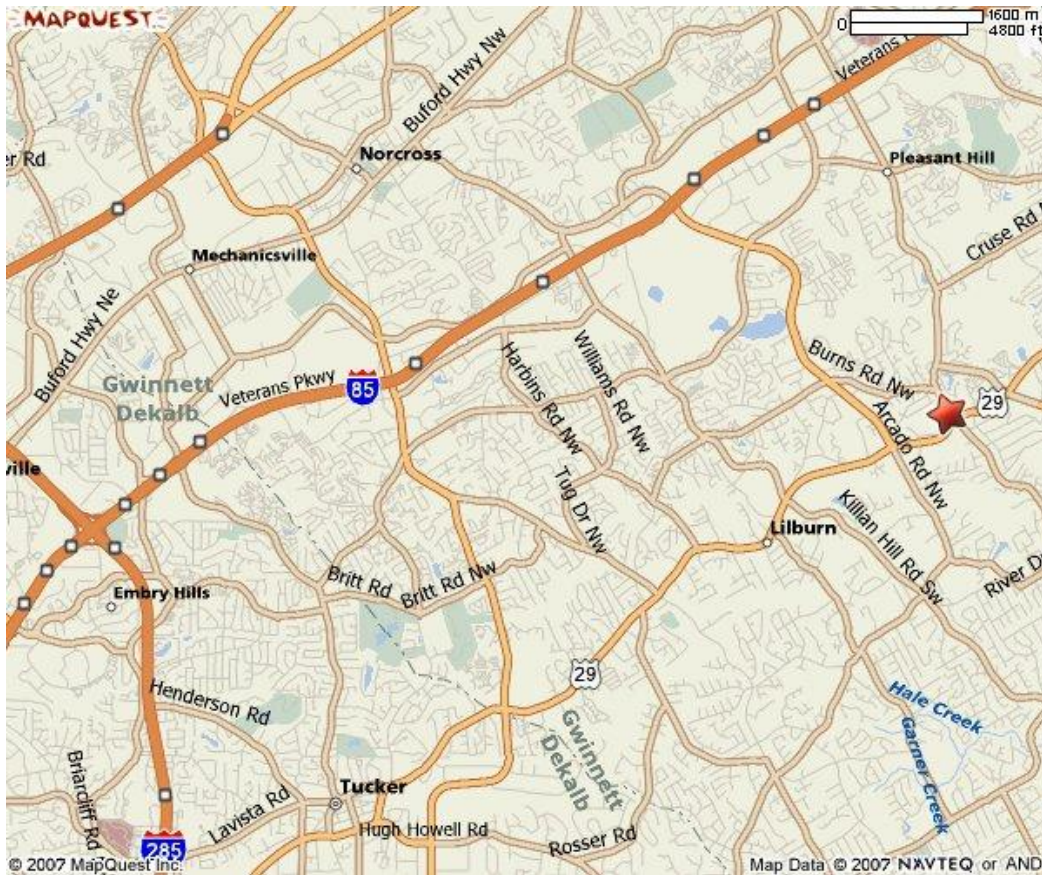

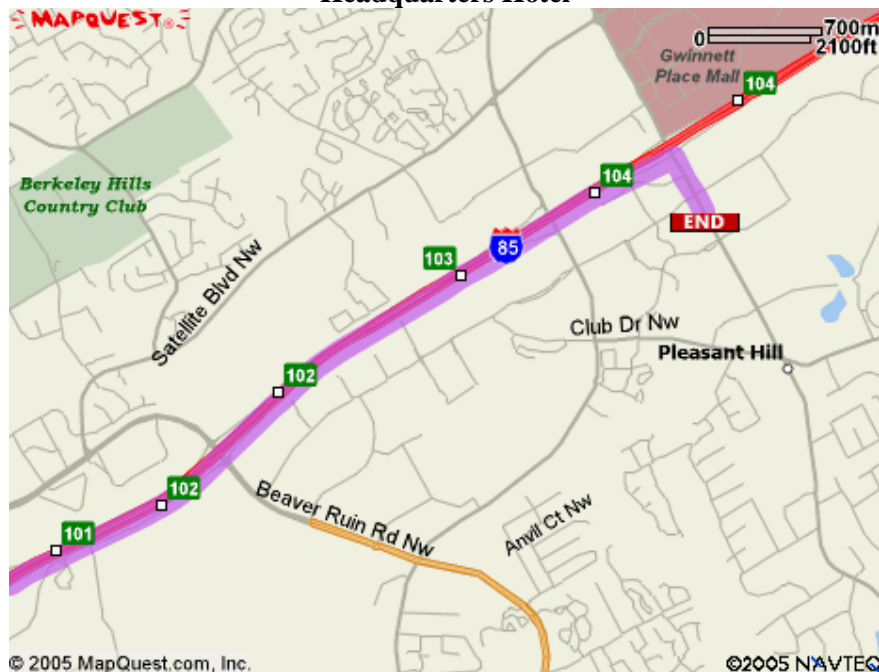
